二十四節氣的冬至

節氣指二十四時節和氣候,是中國古代用來指導農事之曆法。 中國傳統夏曆(農曆)是一種「陰陽合曆」,同時根據日、月 運行製定,「陰」是以朔望月為基準確定,「陽」是以地球自 冬至繞太陽公轉一圈為基準確定歲實。

冬至·又稱冬節、賀冬、冬至節、亞歲,八大天象類節氣之一,與夏至相反。冬至日是一年中白畫最短之日,北半球冬至一般都在西曆12月21日或12月22日。



中國民間有"冬至大如年"一説。這天,家人團聚,祭祀祖 先,慶賀往來,猶如年節.不僅家庭成員間相互飲「節酒」和 食佳節美食慶祝,更會走訪親友居所慶賀送禮和祭奠祖先與神明。

飲食習俗在中國南方和北方也有不同。在中國北方有諺語「冬至餃子夏至麵」, 認為冬天寒冷而人體耗熱量多故應該多食有營養的食品補充熱量。因此有冬至日 有食餃子和餛飩的習俗:吃餛飩寓意破陰釋陽,表達冬至的新舊交接宇宙混沌狀態,更意味親自開闢世界;而吃餃子又俗稱「安耳朵」(擠餃形似耳朵),民間 習俗認為冬至日不食餃子會凍掉耳朵,也不利農事收穫。

在中國南方,某些地方有冬至日食湯糰、粉糍粑等甜食的習俗。冬至日會食用以米麵製成的圓形食品,即「湯團」、「團子」,取圓形象徵天與陽,寓意年終團聚。沿海地區人民更往往把湯團造成紅色與白色以寓意陰陽交泰。民間習俗認為不必等到中國新年,吃過冬節湯圓就表示增加一歲。

今年冬至在12月21日,你的家庭會怎樣慶祝這個節日呢?

Solar terms - Winter Solstice

Solar terms refer to the twenty-four seasons and climate and are the calendar notes used to guide agricultural affairs in ancient China.

The traditional Chinese lunar calendar is a "yin and yang calendar" that is formulated based on the orbit of the moon and rise and set of the sun. "Yin" is determined based on the lunar month, and "Yang" is determined based on the earth's revolution around the sun from the winter solstice.

The winter solstice, also known as the Winter Festival, and Ya Sui, is one of the eight major solar terms, which is the opposite of the summer solstice. The winter solstice is the shortest day of the year. The winter solstice in the northern hemisphere generally falls on December 21 or December 22 in the Western calendar.

There is a saying in Chinese folks that "the winter solstice is as big as a year". On this day, family members will reunite, worship ancestors, and celebrate just like a New Year's Day. Not only do family members drink "festival wine" and eat festive food to celebrate each other, they will also visit relatives and friends' homes to celebrate gifts and pay homage to ancestors and gods.

Eating customs are different in southern and northern China. In northern China, there is a proverb "Dumplings in the winter solstice and noodles in summer solstice." Therefore, there is the custom of eating dumplings and wontons during the winter solstice: eating wontons means breaking the yin and relieving the yang, expressing the chaotic state of the new and old in the winter solstice, and also means opening up the world by yourself; and eating dumplings is also commonly known as "an ear" (squeezing dumplings like ears), folk customs believe that not eating dumplings during the winter solstice will freeze your ears, and it is not good for farming.

In southern China, some places have the custom of winter solstice rice dumplings, sweet rice and other sweets. On the winter solstice, round foods made of sweet rice are eaten, namely sweet dumplings or tanguan. The circle symbolizes the sky and the sun, which means reunion at the end of the year. People in coastal areas often turn the sweet dumplings into red and white to imply the harmony between yin and yang. Folk custom believes that it is not necessary to wait until the Chinese New Year. Eating dumplings during the Winter Festival means one year old.

This year the winter solstice is on December 21st, how will your family celebrate this special day?
