和孩子一起制定新年計劃

新年是慶祝新開始的時間,7-12 歲的孩子正處於定下學習目標的理想階段。新年計劃不但讓我們有所得益,孩子更可以學習自律和制定目標的意義;同時,與孩子一起制定新年計劃,既有趣也是親子良機。

以下一些溫馨提示,可以幫助孩子從制定新年計劃得到裨益。



以身作則

作為父母,言行一致十分重要;因為,孩子把父母所有的生活細節看在眼裡。父母應當表現他們對自己新一年的期望,並且思考如何將孩子包括在計劃中。例如:"今年我要多喝水,因為水對我有好處。你想和我一起多喝水嗎?"

讓孩子自我規劃

您可以指導和建議一些可以作出改變的事項,幫助孩子清楚目標,並確保適合他們的年齡層,讓孩子主導自己的目標並學習如何妥善安排。

保持積極態度

回顧孩子去年的成就,表揚做得好的亮點,並以輕鬆愉快的心情一起討論新年計劃,如果討論時態度強硬嚴厲,孩子很可能會抗拒。

共同作出全家計劃

全家計劃還可以拉近家人彼此的距離。一家人可以計劃每個月做一件善事,然後集思廣益 地思考做甚麼善事:在公園撿垃圾或捐贈舊衣服和玩具給收容所。

制定目標可以教導孩子堅持、專注和計劃的義意。

計劃不要定下太多,幫助你的孩子將廣泛的計劃安排成可行的、循序漸進,指導他們在合適的情況下實現。有了爸媽的參與,也會成為孩子達成目標的最佳動力,而這股動力,將會讓他們對 2022 年充滿期待,努力實踐。







Making New Year's Resolutions with Your Kids

New Year's Day is the traditional time to celebrate a new beginning, and kids ages 7-12 are at the ideal stage to learn to make resolutions. We not only benefit from New Year's resolutions; our children can also learn a lot about self-discipline and the value of making goals. Making resolutions with your children can be fun and exciting and is a good opportunity for family bonding.

Here are some tips on how to help your kids benefit from making resolutions.

Be Resolution Role Models

As parents, it's important to practice what you preach. Just as with everything else you do; your child is watching. Parents should be reflective about how they wish to be in the coming year. Think of how you can include your child in your resolution. "I 'm going to drink more water this year because water is good for me. Do you want to join me?"

Suggest—Don't Dictate—Resolutions

You can guide and suggest general categories for change, help your child clarify goals, and make sure they're age-appropriate, but kids should come up with resolutions themselves. This is how they take ownership of their goals and learn to plan.

Keep a Positive Approach to Resolutions

Start by going over the positive things your kids accomplished last year instead of pointing out their shortcomings. Point to the bright spot where they are doing something well. There's a celebratory feeling to setting goals on New Year's that doesn't exist at other times of the year. Present it optimistically, a lot comes from your tone. If you're putting it in a punishing, preachy way, your kids will be turned off.


Make Family Resolutions Together

Resolutions also bring families closer, especially when you decide to set goals together. Families could plan to do one charitable thing a month and brainstorm about what that might be. You could pick up trash in the park or donate used clothes and toys to a shelter.

Setting goals can teach children persistence, focus and the value of planning.

The important thing is not to end up with too many resolutions, help your kids to break down broad resolutions into doable, step-by-step pieces. Guiding them to be most realistic as you see fit. With the participation of parents, it will also become the best motivation for children to achieve their goals, and this motivation will make them look forward to 2022 and work hard for it.
