# 冬至



**冬**至，又稱冬節、賀冬、冬至節，二十四節氣之第二十二個節氣、八大天象類節氣之一，與夏至相反。冬至日是北半球一年中白晝最短之日，通常在西曆的12月21日或22日。

民間有“吃了湯圓大一歲”之說。從這句俗諺可以看出古代過冬至就如過年、吃湯圓更是過節團員的必備的食物之一，而吃湯圓的習俗背後其實有個溫情的傳說故事：

傳說在古代有一年的冬天特別寒冷，導致好多窮人幾乎都活不下去，有一對夫妻就帶著女兒到城裡，希望能找到好心人施捨一點食物讓他們好過冬。不幸的是，媽媽餓到體力不支過世了，而這戶人家連飯都沒得吃，根本沒有多餘的錢可以把媽媽安葬。

於是，孝順的女兒決定把自己賣給有錢人當僕人，以換得可以安葬媽媽的錢，她還向主人要了糯米丸子給她爸爸吃、幫助爸爸果腹溫飽。

去了有錢人家當僕人的女兒，由於跟爸爸分開了，有一天她靈機一動，在冬至祭拜門神那一天悄悄的把糯米丸子黏在大門上，希望爸爸看到了，會想起一起吃糯米丸子的事。她爸爸真的看見，並與女兒團圓。

因此在冬至時全家圍成一圈搓湯圓，冬至吃湯圓有象徵團圓、美滿的意義。

**W**inter Solstice, also known as Winter Festival, the twenty-second solar term of the twenty-four solar terms, and one of the eight astronomical solar terms, is the opposite of the summer solstice. The winter solstice is the shortest day of the year in the northern hemisphere, usually on December 21 or 22 in the Western calendar.

There is a folk saying that "you will be one year older after eating rice balls". From this proverb, we can see that celebrating the winter solstice in ancient times is like celebrating the New Year, and eating rice balls is one of the must-have foods for members of the festival. There is actually a warm legend behind the custom of eating rice balls:

It is said that in ancient times, the winter was so cold that many poor people could hardly survive. A couple took their daughter to the city, hoping to find a kind person to give them some food to survive the winter. Unfortunately, the mother died of starvation, and the family didn't even have food to eat, and there was no money left to bury her.

So, the daughter decided to sell herself to a rich family as a servant in exchange for money to bury her mother. She also asked the master for rice balls for her father to eat so he won't be hungry.

When she went to the rich man's house as a servant, how would her father find her? One day she had an idea. On the day of winter solstice worshipping the door god, she quietly stuck rice balls to the door. She hoped her father would see them and remember eating rice balls together. Fortunately, he did and was reunited with his daughter.

Therefore, during the winter solstice, the whole family gathers in a circle, makes rice balls and eats them. Eating rice balls during the winter solstice symbolizes reunion and happiness.
