David Lei - PRESENTER
David Lei (he/him) immigrated to San Francisco's Chinatown as a child in 1956 and later became a community historian. After a career in social work and business, he now leads efforts to preserve Chinese American heritage, directs the Chinese New Year parade, and gives talks on art, history, and culture.

Anna Eng - PANELIST
Anna Eng (she/her) is a historian and lecturer at UC Berkeley and San Francisco State University. She co-leads a project digitizing Chinese community archives and teaches about Chinese American history, focusing on the lives of immigrant families and the ties of the generations in the Chinese American community.

Vivien Leung - PANELIST
Vivien Leung (she/they) is an assistant professor at Santa Clara University specializing in American politics, racial politics, and quantitative methods. Their research areas include race, immigration, political psychology, and Asian American identity.

Connie Young Yu - PANELIST
Connie Young Yu (she/her) is a Chinese American writer, historian and activist. She authored books such as 'Chinatown San Jose, U.S.A.' and helped win National Historic Landmark status for the Angel Island Immigration Station. Her work highlights overlooked experiences of Chinese and Asian Americans.
